Message from the President

Greetings!

As many of you know, during our May 16th membership meeting, much discussion was had concerning our future involvement in the Kernersville Spring Folly. A motion was made and seconded to discontinue our participation in the Folly. A second motion was made and seconded to terminate our membership in the Kernersville Chamber of Commerce. Both motions passed during the subsequent voting.

Since the May meeting, several of our Board members and other active members of the club who were not able to be present during that meeting have contacted me or other members of the Board and voiced their disappointment with the results of those votes and their wish that they had had an opportunity to participate in the discussions that led to those votes. One of those members reminded me that during our March 21st membership meeting, a similar discussion was had concerning our involvement in the Folly. As documented in the approved minutes of the March meeting, the discussions during that meeting did not result in any satisfactory decisions and, in the interest of wrapping up the meeting, a motion was made to table the discussion, and any action on it, until the June 20th membership meeting. The motion was seconded and approved in the subsequent voting. This delay would make the final financial results of this year's Folly Car Show available for consideration during the future discussions. It would also enable the entire membership to be aware that the issue was under consideration and, if any of them felt strongly about the issue, they would have the opportunity to participate in any discussions and subsequent votes concerning the issue.

Because the March vote to table discussions and decisions concerning our club's continued participation in the Spring Folly until June preceded the votes taken at the May meeting, I believe it is necessary to open the issue for discussion again in our June 20th meeting and, then, vote again on the motions (or revisions, thereof) made during the May meeting. This would allow any member who was not present in May, and who would have liked to have had the opportunity to express an opinion on the issues before a final vote, to do so. The result of the June voting will supersede those from the May votes. Therefore, if you would like to express your opinion and/or vote on the continued participation of our club in the Spring Folly and our membership in the Chamber of Commerce, it is important for you to attend next Tuesday's meeting.

I apologize for the need to revisit an important issue that was supposedly already settled. I should have known before placing it on the May agenda that the discussion and voting on this issue should not have been allowed to go forward until June. See you on Tuesday!

The museum is a source of education and fun for the young and old.” There are also some Classic cars on display as well as some AACA items and memorabilia. NOTE: There is a lot of walking here so be sure to wear comfortable shoes.

They offer a 25-minute train ride at 1:30 pm for those that would like to do that. This is a narrated tour of the 60-acre site and is pulled by an antique diesel engine. Admission for the train ride and the Museum is \$10 per Senior/Military, \$12 Adults. For those that only want to go into the Museum, it is only \$5 per Senior/Military, \$6 Adult. Again, please be prepared to pay your own admission at the time of entry.
